Responsibilities include:

- Monitoring program results and developing reports and technical briefs for donors and other stakeholders;
- Leading program development for new programs and ensuring education technical design and quality;
- Organizing research and learning events to support the evidence building and achievement of the program targets and objectives;
- Building and maintaining relationship with internal and external partners/stakeholders to enhance quality and sustainability in programs;
